

# TREATMENT OF SKIN LESIONS / RASHES

## A. RASHES / DERMATITIS / TINEA PEDIS

- Treated conservatively with topical and / or oral medications
- Not responding to traditional care – Small biopsy of the rash may be performed to confirm diagnosis.

## B. SUSPICIOUS LESIONS / MOLES / SUN SPOTS / ETC

- **Highly recommended simple in office biopsy to rule skin cancer.**
- **With skin cancers on the rise, the multiple types of skin cancers (basal cell, squamous cell, verruca carcinoma, amelanotic melanoma to name a few) these lesions can fool even the most highly trained skin professionals. \*A simple 2 minute in office biopsy will confirm the diagnosis and believe it or not, could save your life. Early detection of these is key to treatment.\***



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
